happening with

immigrants on our borders? Take that energy and use if for good. Make a positive response by joining Old First Presbyterian Church - San Francisco and the International Rescue Committee (IRC) to give travel bags and comfort items for asylum-seeking families. These families must take long bus journeys from Arizona to destinations across the U.S., where they will join relatives or friends. As the situation stands now, people are left at churches, community centers, on the streets with literally nothing and have to find their way to their families.

The travel bags will include a specific list of items, such as travel blankets, inflatable pillows, wipes, coloring books, playing cards and small flashlights. Our goal is to fill travel bags for four families with the items that the IRC has requested. The items range from travel

blankets and pillows, reusable water bottles, cliff bars, wet wipes, travel kits for children, a hand towel and washcloth, chap stick to name just a few items. We estimate that each travel bag with contents will cost \$200. Old First wants to at least get 5 bags sent to the border.

With your donated funds our We Choose Welcome team will do the shopping. When the drive is completed, we will have a "packing party" at coffee hour on Sunday, August 18 to fill the travel bags, so we can get them to the IRC! Session

Session met in a Special (Stated) meeting on July 7, 2019, for the purpose of receiving the PNC report re nomination of pastor. The following actions were unanimously approved:

- Motion to approve the nominee, the Rev. Dr. L. Don Smith.
- Motion to approve the Terms of Call for Rev. Smith.
- *Motion to set dates to announce the name of the successful candidate to the congregation on July 14 and July 21.
- *Motion for Information letter to be sent to the congregation during the week of July 8.
- *Motion to set date, July 28, for congregational meeting to approve candidate.

However, as we know from Robert Burns' poem, "To a Mouse," the best-laid plans of mice and men often go awry. So, the last three motions marked with an asterisk did not come to fruition because Presbytery's Committee on Ministry (COM) was on vacation during the month of July. Their approval of the nominee and the terms of call are required before we can set the date of the congregational meeting, newly announced now as August 18. We should soon have a happy conclusion to our search for a pastor.

At a second Special meeting on July 21, guest-moderated by Rev. Janet Bower of COM, motions were unanimously approved of revisions within the Terms of Call for Rev. Smith. Given our current budget, Broadmoor is limited

to a half-time pastor. Our congregation must accept the facts. A half-time pastor means just that: he or she preaches only half the time, with other Sundays to be filled from pulpit supply or by inviting speakers from within the community or nongovernment agencies (NGOs).

Elders and Deacons met in Tweedie Hall on Saturday, July 13, from 9:00-1:00 for an informative officer retreat. Rev. Kamal Hassan conducted an outstanding educational and inspiring officer training workshop.
