turkey. Thanks to Republic Services for donating 30 bags for this project.

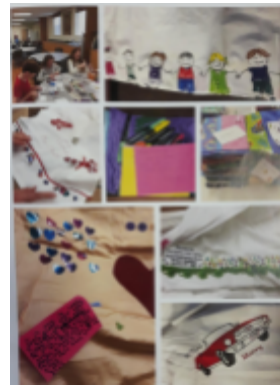

Presbyterian Women

Earlier this year we asked the congregation for donations of pillowcases and notions for the PW Youth Triennium Together in Service Puerto Rico pillowcase project. In an article in the September/October 2019 issue of Horizons magazine, it states that pillowcases arrived by the dozens (approximately 2,500). All of us and Presbyterian Women around the world responded lovingly, creatively and generously.

Sent to Puerto Rico in August and September, the pillowcases are being distributed through churches and schools in the three presbyteries on the island of Puerto Rico.
