### *From the Pastor*

Dear Broadmoor Presbyterian Community,

Although we did not receive the April showers that we so desperately need, we did receive showers of blessings: Easter celebration, laughter at the Holy Humor Service, a joint worship service with the St. Andrew congregation, and this coming Sunday we will make a joyful noise at our Hymn Sing Sunday. Additionally, we began to upgrade our technology in order to begin hybrid worship services. Our beloved and talented music director, Janet Haddox, has learned new software allowing her to enrich our hymns played so beautifully by pianist Evelyn Masuda. Our administrative assistant, Martha Espinosa, continues to manage our physical office while managing our online presence. And, Session discerns God’s call while supporting our team as we build towards the future.

At our recent meeting, Session approved to set aside financial resources to begin upgrading our technology in the sanctuary. Janet, Ray and I met with Michael Hatfield and his team last week in the sanctuary to go over options. We are looking at a three-step process over the next year. First, we plan to install screens so folks can

come to the sanctuary to enjoy the Zoom service. Next, we will upgrade the microphone and Internet in order to live-stream the sermon and liturgy from the sanctuary. The final step will involve upgrading the speakers, piano mic, and choral mic so we can live stream the entire worship service. This is an evolving process and the time frame is open ended. We believe that these upgrades are not just a short-term solution. Rather, they will propel us into the future allowing us to remain connected with our church family across distances and health restrictions.

I admit, this process has layers of complication. For example, after meeting with the technicians last week, we realized our Internet is too slow to live-stream. Yet, as we stumble along, we do so with the support and care of one another. Session and I are here to answer questions and discuss ideas. So, let us all pray as the worship team prays every Sunday, “God make the technology work as you see fit, and give us the flexibility to deal with it. Amen.”

## *Session*

Session met virtually in a Regular (Stated) meeting on April 15, 2021, with the Rev. Karen Thistlethwaite as Guest Moderator. The following motions took place, all approved unanimously:

- To send the approved Mission Study Report and the Ministry Information Form to the Presbytery's Committee on Ministry.
- To use the Presbytery's \$5,000 grant from the memorial fund to upgrade the technology in the sanctuary to provide hybrid worship and to offer more opportunities for future events.
- To safely begin hybrid in-person worship once the sanctuary can provide for hybrid worship.
- To remove the two-signature requirement from the checking account at Wells Fargo to be able to make on-line purchases with the Wells Fargo debit card.
- For the internal (BPC) policy to continue requiring two signatures on all BPC checks.
- Request to rent the sanctuary for a wedding, Sunday, July 4, 2021, from 3:00-6:00 p.m. Approved with proviso to observe safety precautions and hire professional cleaning after the event.
- Request to rent space to Villa Sinfonia with safety precautions in place during the months of April and May.

- One motion was denied by unanimous vote to rent space to Casa de Oración because we lack the space for them at the present time.
