Session met virtually in a Regular (Stated) meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 21, 2021, with the Rev. Karen Thistlethwaite as Guest Moderator.

The following motions were approved:

- Rental fee increases beginning January 1, 2022.
- Allow use of the church kitchen to renters to warm up food (no cooking) and serve beverages in Tweedie Hall following “restaurant rules,” masked and socially-distanced, seated while consuming food and beverages.
- Background: Previously, the Nominating Committee has searched for three elders and three deacons for the upcoming term. Motion: Approve PNC’s recommendation to reduce this number from three to two officers per class for three-year terms, to be brought forward for vote at the next meeting of the congregation. The changes in the bylaws need to be ratified by the congregation at the annual meeting on January 30, 2022.

Items discussed:

- Approval of over budget Item for account 5603 Youth Activities: Youth activities and Camp Budget is \$800.00. The Balance in the account is \$137.02 There will be 9 family and youth to attend Westminster Woods Saturday October 23. The cost is \$80.00 per person; the total cost would be \$720.00. Seeking recommendation from Finance to present to Session to cover over budget cost (\$582.98) to be charged to #5603 Youth Activities.
- Audio Visual Co coordinator has been interviewed and offered the position. Processing will begin as soon as possible.

- Staff will be offered a Health savings account opportunity. BPC will match staff contribution not to exceed \$1,000.00.
- Tenant rent increases and staff salaries will be reviewed and recommendations will be made at the November Session meeting.
