From the Pastor

Dear Broadmoor Community,

After four weeks on the East Coast caring for family I am back in the Bay Area. Although we have been apart, and will continue to be apart for the next four months, the life of the church continues to thrive. The Thursday Meditation group continues to pray for our community. The Fellowship Team is hosting a Bingo Night on the first Tuesday of October, and a fall family costume night on the third Tuesday. Our Stewardship campaign will begin in October and the Mission Team continues to raise and provide money for various mission partners. Needless to say, we continue to be the body of Christ in our communities and in the world.

As part of the global Body of Christ the Session voted in favor of joining the San Francisco Presbytery in becoming a Matthew 25 church. What does it mean to be a Matthew 25 church? I am glad you asked.

- Eradicating systemic poverty by working to change laws, policies, plans and structures in our society that perpetuate economic exploitation of people who are poor.

- Dismantling structural racism by advocating and acting to break down the systems, practices and thinking that underlie discrimination, bias, prejudice and oppression of people of color.

I am excited to partner with you all as we live into our calling.

Stewardship



Why We Pledge

In last year's stewardship month we looked at scriptures to find out why we pledge. On each of four Sundays a different scripture passage was used to highlight all the gifts that God has given us. It was inspired by an article by Rev. Greg Allen-Picket *

In *Genesis (1:1 - 5)* we find that we are created as Imago Deo (image of God). The question asked is what is our image of God. While every person may have a different image of God there are two extremes with many other views in the middle. Some view God as a judge sitting on a throne on high dealing out punishment for our misdeeds and rewarding our good ones. The people who think this way pledge out of a fear that they will be punished if they do not give or that by giving they can buy God forgiveness. Others view God as a loving, benevolent Creator, who is ready to forgive and embrace all of us even when we fall short of his intentions for us. These people give out of their gratitude for all the gifts and grace that God has given to us. In *Exodus (16:11 - 16)* we found that God doesn't give us just the bare

minimum, but gives abundantly. In the story of Joseph (*Genesis 45:37 - 50*) we learned that God gives us the ability to forgive. It also shows that we may not understand how God will provide for us, but it will be done, and God is in control of how it will occur. In the parable of the mustard seed (*Matthew 13:31 - 32, Mark 4:30-32 and Luke 13:18-19*) it is explained that even the smallest gift can be used by God. In *Matthew (6:26 - 33)* we are told not to worry. God will provide and we are invited to share generously out of that provision.

This year we will look at *Genesis (9:1 - 3, 16 - 17)*, *Psalms (24:1 - 5)*, *Proverbs (3:5 - 9)*, *Luke (10:25 - 29)*, and *Peter (4:8 - 11)*.

COVID-19 Emergency Rental Assistance



Has COVID-19 created a financial hardship for you? If you rent your home and meet the following criteria, you may be eligible for up to \$5,000 in emergency rental assistance:

- Live in the City of Daly City
- Are experiencing a loss of income due to COVID-19
- Have a documented need for assistance that is not duplicated by another source.
- Can provide a lease agreement or letter confirming tenancy from your landlord
- Have been current on rent payments prior to COVID-19
- Have a household income less than the income limits for your household size:

Application Process

Complete an application to the Daly City Partnership's (DCP) Financial Assistance Program at www.dcpartnership.org/covid. Paper applications may be obtained at the Daly City Community Service Center at 350 - 90th Street. DCP staff will contact qualifying applicants for supplemental information on a first come first serve basis. Funding availability is limited.
