Presbyterian Women

Second Mile Giving is what the Presbyterian Women give. The First Mile is our pledge to the Congregation.

The Fellowship of the Least Coin is given at each Gathering. The Fellowship was begun in 1956 by Shanti Solomon encouraging women around the world to give the least coin of their currency. Broadmoor usually gives on the average of about \$30.00 a year. The money is disbursed around the world to programs supporting women.

The Birthday Offering came from the southern Presbyterian women when the two denominations merged many years ago. An example of the grants that are given each year, a number of years ago Glenda Hope applied for a grant to be used in the Tenderloin, the grant given \$50,000 was the seed money that helped to build an apartment building that helped

women get out of sex trafficking in San Francisco.

The Thank Offering which is taken in the fall is distributed mostly in the United States. The Synod of Mid America, Presbytery of Giddings-Lovejoy received \$10,000 for a program, Light for the Darkness New Worshiping Community, Grounded Gardening. The grant supported the purchase of gardening supplies, advertising and stipends for lead gardeners and facilitators who also guide meditation.

Honorary Life Membership program honors individuals faithful service to the Presbyterian Women and to the congregation. Richard Murray is our most recent recipient.

Broadmoor Presbyterian Women put aside \$400.00 each year which is given to the woman who attends the Churchwide Gathering that is held every three years. Martha received \$1,200.00 toward the registration and other expenses.
