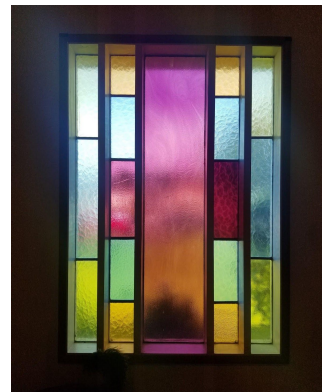

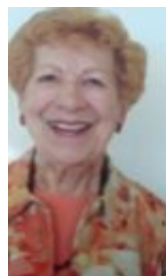
Session

Session met virtually in a Regular (Stated) meeting on January 21, 2021, with the Rev. Karen Thistlethwaite as Guest Moderator. The following motions, all approved unanimously, took place:

- For the Clerk of Session to submit BPC’s 2020 Church Statistical Report online to the San Francisco Presbytery.
- For Finance to renew a one-year CD with the Synod of the Pacific due 2/15/21. The current amount of the CD is \$20,881.97; the current interest rate is 1.95%.
- To add Bookkeeper Peggy Draper’s name to the list of signatories for BPC’s bank accounts. This will streamline the banking process.
- To combine Christian Education and Fellowship into a single ministry team, to be known as the Faith Formation Ministry Team.
- For Session to seek the congregation’s approval at the Annual Meeting to suspend the rule in BPC’s bylaws for a year to reduce the slate of elders from nine to seven.
