

#### **MESSAGE FROM SESSION**

The month of August started out with a stunning and delightful surprise: a letter from San Francisco Presbytery presenting Broadmoor with a gift of \$5000.00. Each congregation in the San Francisco Presbytery has received this letter and gift, to be used as we are led by the Holy Spirit for mission in our local community. Session is asked to use these funds "to connect a passion of our congregation with a specific need in the community." If we wish, we may even pool our money and partner with other congregations. In accepting this invitation, we are asked to share, both by e-mail and verbally at the next regional meeting of the Presbytery of San Francisco, how the money was used. As you see, exciting decisions are to come.

Ordinarily, the summer months are relatively quiet for Session, but not this year! We prepared and submitted the contract to S. F. Presbytery. Based on BPC's current income level, although we would have liked to offer a full-time position, the choice of the salary package for the incoming Interim Pastor had to be reduced to 75%. Presbytery informed us that they have received our contract but cautioned that a three-quarter time position is difficult to fill.

The next steps are these: Presbytery will give us a list of candidates. Session will interview and select the Interim Pastor. Session and the chosen candidate will negotiate the terms of the contract, which will be submitted to the Committee on Ministry (COM) for approval. The contract is signed and approved by Presbytery. The Interim will serve as our temporary pastor for 12-18 months until we call our new pastor.

We hope to start as soon as possible on the formation of the committee to write the Mission Study. Representatives from various groups within the church serve on this committee, so give some thought right away as to whom you might select. Only one member from Session is to serve. As mentioned before, the goal of the Mission Study is to clarify who we are, what we stand for, how we operate, what we are doing, how well we are doing it, and where we are going next. We hope that the Interim will guide us through preparation of the Mission Study. It is necessary to be approved by Presbytery so that we may eventually form a Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) for the new permanent pastor.

We continue to identify our next steps in ministry. Who are we? What is God calling us to be? Where is God calling us to go? We ask that you be with us in spirit on this journey.
