## Faith Formation



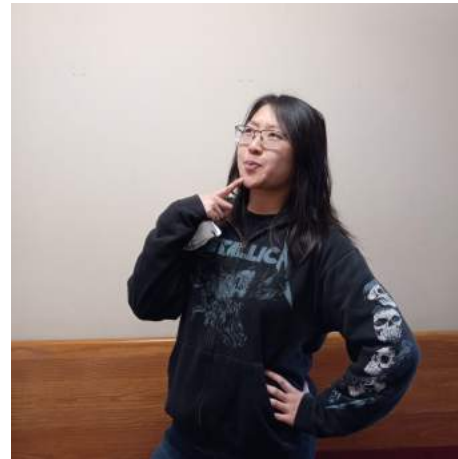
We recently gifted Elaine her personal bible. She has grown in her Christian faith and we hope to help her

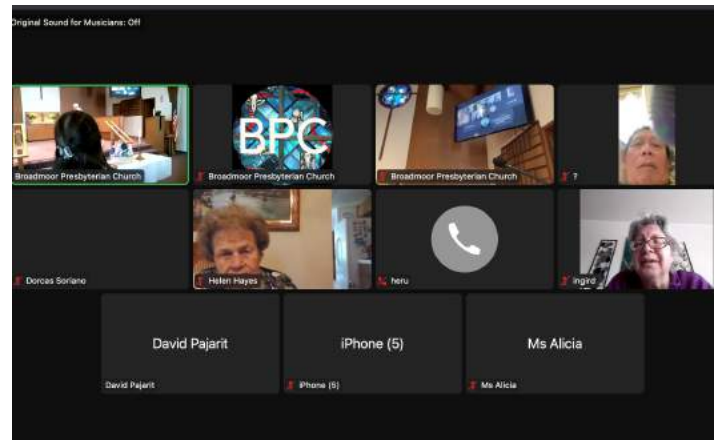

### Household Hazardous Waste Events

San Mateo County residents can safely dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW) free of charge at special drop-off collection events four times a year.

Event Details

The collection events take place from 8:30 am to 12:15 pm. To participate, residents must schedule an appointment at San Mateo County's HHW Program by calling 650-363-4718, select option 3.

Don't Wait for an Event

You do not have to wait for a collection event to dispose of HHW! Residents unable to attend the events can still dispose of HHW for free at San Mateo County's permanent HHW facility, Thursdays through Saturdays (except major holiday weekends). You must make an appointment, call 650-363-4718, select option 3. Remaining 2023 dates are Saturday, September 9 and Saturday, December 9.
