Thank you for partnering with the Presbyterian Foundation to administer your online giving program.

The Presbyterian Foundation collaborates with Vanco Payment Solutions. As part of your online giving services, your donors had access to a mobile app through Vanco called GivePlus which allowed them to make contributions from their smartphones.

Vanco has converted from the current GivePlus app to the new Vanco Mobile Faith Engagement app, which will offer functionality similar to the GivePlus app.

This change only affects donors who use the GivePlus app. Donors who give through your website are not affected.

No action is required from your organization to make this change. Donors can search for your organization using the name, city, or unique invitation code listed below. Please feel free to distribute this code to your donors.
