This is what Advent is all about. We will soon enter the darkest time of the year, a season known as Advent in the church. This year Advent begins on November 27<sup>th</sup>. It is a time of hopeful waiting and watching for the newness of life to come – the Light of the Christ Child.

Advent is a metaphor for our living. It is about having faith especially during the darkest moments – when we feel alone, lost, anxious, and not sure what comes next – when the sense of hope, peace, love, and joy we talk about during Advent does not seem present in our lives or in the life of the world.
