Presbyterian Disaster Assistance



As we see the news and hear the stories of the devastating fires consuming parts of Maui, Hawai'i, our hearts are broken and filled with sadness. Authorities are calling these fires the deadliest natural disaster in state history. More than 2,000 buildings have been significantly damaged – over 80% of those residential homes, with thousands of families displaced – and wildlife habitats have been destroyed, their environment in jeopardy. More than 100 deaths have been confirmed, and sadly, the number keeps increasing.

In collaboration with the Presbytery of the Pacific and its leadership, PDA has been in communication with pastors in the affected communities and elsewhere in Hawai'i. PDA has already released emergency grants to meet the urgent needs of the communities and to provide immediate care. The magnitude of the event will require the development of long-term projects and assistance, both for the physical and emotional long-lasting effects. Presbyterians from Oʻahu are participating in coordination

calls with other nonprofit and faith-based disaster organizations to ensure that no one is forgotten. PDA affirms our commitment to accompany those affected by this disaster. As people of God, once again we are called to stand with our siblings in the "GAP" - Give, Act and Gifts can be online Pray. made pcusa.org/hawaiifires or by check made payable Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) Filipino Bayanihan Resource Center (PBRC)



Philippine Consul General in San Francisco Neil Ferrer and **PBRC** leader Perla **Ibarrientos** the lead hoisting of the Philippine national flag at a special ceremony at

the Daly City Hall on 13 June 2023.

In his remarks, Consul General Ferrer said that the Philippine flag-raising ceremony highlights Daly City's "solidarity and fellowship with the 34,000 Filipino Americans currently residing in this beautiful city." The 34,000 FilAm residents represent 30% of DalyCity's total population of over 100.000 making it the highest concentration of Filipino Americans in any city in the U.S. Following all speeches, Consul General Ferrer and PBRC founder Perla Ibarrientos, who initiated the very first Philippine Independence Day flag-raising at Daly City Hall in 2014, led the hoisting of the Philippine national flag. Following the outdoor flag-raising, the PBRC hosted a luncheon for all attendees.
